

Instructions for students seeking admission under Management Quota

General Instructions:

1. The candidate must read the conditions of eligibility for admission as given in the Admission Brochure for 2024-25 and must satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility.
2. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that they fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria in the programmes they seek admission; the correctness of the details filled with respect to region; category or any other such details for allotment of seat. If at any stage of admission procedure, the information furnished by the candidate is found to be incorrect or untrue the admission to the programme shall be cancelled and the fees will be forfeited.
3. All candidates who wish to participate in the Management Quota Admissions in various Programmes for Academic Session 2024-25 are advised in their own interest to visit below website for regular updates.

4. For most of the UG Programme calculating aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination aggregate marks of best 5 subjects should be taken which includes English and the mandatory subjects as prescribed in the Admission Brochure.
5. For programmes like BBA & BCA calculating aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination aggregate marks of best 4 subjects should be taken which includes English. However, eligibility of the applicants should be ascertained as per the eligibility in the Admission Brochure.
6. Students must submit the completed Management Quota Admission Form either physically at the college reception or via email to - info@kamalinstitute.com
7. Students are advised to make a non-refundable payment of Rs. 2500/- towards the Management Quota Registration. This payment is essential for the processing the application.

8. Any application without DD No., UTR No., or Transaction No. will not be accepted.
